## **SB1176 RECKLESS DRIVING PROGRAM FACT SHEET**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The SB1176 program is a 45 to 90 day outpatient alcohol/drug education program consisting of 12 hours of curriculum in our facility (approximately 1.5 to 3 hours of involvement per week).

### **INTAKE/EVALUATION INTERVIEW**

The Intake/Evaluation interview is a **scheduled**, 1-hour interview to evaluate your treatment needs and to schedule your curriculum. **(SB1176 program does not have verification of enrollment forms for the DMV because it is court ordered and not recognized by the DMV.)**

### **CURRICULUM**

8-Alcohol/Drug Awareness Education Classes (1.5 Hours Per Class)		

NOTE: Program length will be approximately 45-90 days and **TOTAL ABSTINENCE** is required during this time.

### **FEE SCHEDULE**

The fee for the SB1176 Program is \$240. (Suggested fee schedule is \$120 down at intake and \$120 at completion.)

NOTE: No client has ever been refused service due to lack of funds. Any alterations in the fee or fee schedule must be discussed with the Program Director.

\* This program is court ordered and is not recognized by the DMV to meet your restricted license requirement. The DMV may request you to enroll and complete the AB541 (three-month first-offender program) to obtain your restricted license if you had a .08 Blood Alcohol Concentration or higher at the time of the arrest. The SB1176 program has no verification of enrollment/completion forms for the DMV. These forms are only available for first offenders through the AB541 three-month program.
